STAR meetings: When, where? Attendance at the Action Team meetings has fallen off considerably this year. We have speculated about the cause, and are not sure. We selected our current meeting location for the first half of 2018 based on connection to SacTRU, however, there has been only some cross-pollination. We also selected it based on accessibility, both for handicapped and for frequent bus service. However, that has not turned out to be significant for attendees. So, should we stick with Organize Sacramento, or go back to the Cathcart's, or ??? Another issue may be the day of week and time. We had much higher attendance when we met Wednesdays at 6:30 (though the day of week and time varied). Should we go back to a weekday evening schedule? The drop off may also be due to circumstances beyond our control. We know that the advocacy community is overcommitted and overwhelmed. Maybe there are few people for whom transit is their top priority.

And should we meet more often, or less often? Less reduces stress. More means we can address topics in depth.
